## MINUTES OF THE WINNEBAGO CITY COUNCIL

April 16<sup>th</sup>, 2012

A special meeting of the Winnebago City Council was held on Monday April 16<sup>th</sup>, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. in the Municipal Center Council Chambers.

Mayor Nowak called the meeting to order and conducted roll call. Council members present: Johnson, Ziegler, Robertson, Scofield. Staff Present: City Administrator Bless.

Motion by Johnson, seconded by Ziegler to approve the proposed meeting agenda of April 16<sup>th</sup>. Mayor Nowak called for a vote. The following voted in favor: Johnson, Ziegler, Robertson, Scofield. Motion carried.

### Public Comment

The Mayor opened the meeting to the public for comment.

Tom Hoffman of WFS stated he was there to reconfirm the last block of 1<sup>st</sup> Ave SW (after 4<sup>th</sup> St) would still be a truck route with a 10 ton street for usage at the scale.

Robertson asked if that is the simplest way to get to the scale or if there was another way to do it. Hoffman stated the semi just can't make the loop there with the alley.

Ziegler stated he wants to be on the record saying the last block needs to be 10 ton.

Hoffman reconfirmed with supervisors they will still be doing anhydrous, LP, and dumping beans at the location for several years.

Johnson stated he appreciated Hoffman's attendance to clarify everything.

There being no further public comments the Mayor closed the meeting to the public.

### 1<sup>st</sup> Ave SE Bonds

Bless presented the bond information. Motion by Johnson, second by Ziegler, to approve Resolution 522-2012 issuing bonds Series 2012B. Mayor Nowak called for a vote. The following voted in favor: Johnson, Ziegler, Robertson, Scofield. Motion carried.


