A special meeting of the Winnebago City Council was held on Tuesday June 18th, 2013 at 5:00 p.m. in the Municipal Center Council Chambers.

Mayor Schutt called the meeting to order and conducted roll call. Council members present: Johnson, Robertson, Anderson and Weerts. Staff Present: City Administrator Ziegler, Deputy City Clerk Boeck.

Motion by Robertson, seconded by Johnson to approve the proposed meeting agenda of June 18th with the addition of Mosquito Spraying. Mayor Schutt called for a vote. The following voted in favor: Johnson, Robertson, Anderson and Weerts. Motion carried.

General Business

City Wide Cleanup Discussion

Johnson feels purchasing (3) 3 yard dumpsters would be the best option for City wide clean up. Each resident would have the opportunity to utilize the dumpsters and receive one free dump per year. Johnson stated it would make things easier on the budget compared to a curb side clean up. Robertson agrees. Dale Foster of B & B Sanitation will contact the company for the purchase and report back on the price and expected turnaround time. Motion Anderson, seconded by Johnson to purchase the dumpsters. Discussion held. Mayor Schutt called for a vote. The following voted in favor: Johnson, Robertson, Anderson and Weerts. Motion carried.

Mosquito Spraying


